VINCA PPP Project nominated for Transformational Business Awards 2020

Beo Cista Energija – a joint-venture formed by SUEZ, ITOCHU Corporation (ITOCHU) and MARGUERITE is proud to announce that VINCA PPP project in partnership with the City of Belgrade has been nominated among finalists for the Award – Core Category of Transformational Technology in Urban Infrastructure by Financial Times/International Finance Corporation (World Bank Group) Transformational Business Awards in 2020, the leading global initiative that highlights ground-breaking, long-term private sector solutions to major development issues, with the core categories directly related to global efforts to achieve the UN Sustainable Development Goals.

This award is related particularly to SDG 9 “Build resilient infrastructure, promote inclusive and sustainable industrialisation and foster innovation”, and SDG 11 “Make cities and human settlements inclusive, safe, resilient and sustainable”. It highlights projects that address the most crucial infrastructure needs in the fast-growing cities of the developing world, with long-term socio-economic impact.

The VINCA PPP project (which involves the old landfill remediation and the construction of an Energy-from-waste plant, a sanitary landfill with biogas recovery and leachate treatment facility and a CDW recycling unit) has at least 7 contributions to UN SDGs.

This project and its unique solution will minimize impact on the environment and provide energy from waste in accordance with EU standards & Best Available Techniques. This project is being implemented with the support of International Financial Institutions such as International Finance Corporation (IFC), the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD), the Development Bank of Austria (OeEB) and Multilateral Investment Guarantee Agency (MIGA).
